## **Corn Roast – Sunday September 3**

This annual family event will be at the Scandinavian Community Centre at 6540 Thomas Street in Burnaby, just off Kensington and just north of Hwy 1.

We have rented the facility from 10 AM to 4 PM, including the 160 seat banquet rooms and the playing field, where our “collector” cars will be displayed. There is also a large off-street parking lot for “day drivers”.

You can arrive any time after 10 AM, anticipating that cooked corn to be available at 1:00 PM.

Because of the very large attendance at this event (150 people in 2015 and 2016), and challenges in having sufficient volunteers for food service, this year there will be a food truck on site, to provide lunch for \$ 8 / person, The menu includes the following options:

- one of: pulled pork, or chicken, or hamburger

- a cold beverage (water or soft drink)
- cake.

Since running out of food is something that we do not want to do, advance sign-up is required. The first opportunity will be at the June Chapter Meeting.
