Annual Events and Tours

The Vancouver Chapter organizes a number of events and tours during the year, some of which are for members only and others are open to the public to participate in. The list below is not necessarily complete.

Easter Parade - takes place on Easter Sunday from a designated location to another location for snacks. Open to the Public - token charge to public at destination

May Tour - this is organized by a different chapter each year and takes place in that chapter's area. All members of the Vintage Car Club are able to participate.

Coastal Swap meet - takes place at Tradex near Abbotsford near the end of May. Open to the public.

Strawberry Social - A member only one day event, this is usually in June and may include a garage tour. Sometimes affiliated club members may be invited as well.

Carousel Picnic - takes place at the Burnaby Village carousel and is only for members and invited guests. This event is in the last week of July.

Corn Roast - A members and invited guests only event that is held on the first Sunday in September.

Fall Tour - A members only tour that varies in location each year. Usually 3 or 4 days in duration.

Boxing Day event - Open to the public, the starting point is the Vancouver Planetarium parking lot. The tour route goes through Stanley Park and ends up at the Burnaby Heritage Railway location for coffee, juice and snacks as well as rides on the railway train.
