

Vancouver Chapter of the Vintage Car Club of Canada Annual Events and Tours

Some of these events are for members only while others are open to the public. This list is not necessarily complete as other member only events take place.

Easter Parade - takes place on Easter Sunday from the back parking lot at Trev Deeley on Boundary Road to another location for snacks. Open to the public - token charge to public at destination

May Tour - this is organized by a different chapter of the Vintage Car Club each year and takes place in that chapter's area. All members of the club are able to participate.

Coastal Swap meet - takes place at Tradex near Abbotsford near the end of May. Open to the public.

Strawberry Social - A member only one day event, this is usually in June and may include a garage tour.

Carousel Picnic - takes place at the Burnaby Village carousel in July and is only for members and invited guests.

2400 Motel - held in early August at 2400 Kingsway, Vancouver. Usually there is musical entertainment and light snacks. Appropriate era cars with no major modifications will be admitted. The public is welcome to check out the cars.
